The new park plan includes guiding principles, goals and policies to maintain and enhance the City's parks and open spaces, evaluation of facilities, and recommendations. YOU ARE INVITED to attend the hearing and make oral and/ or written comments. The Planning Commission Chair has the discretion to limit testimony to relevant comments and to set time limits. If you are unable to attend, written comments, photographs or other exhibits on the application may be submitted before the hearing date.

A Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) was issued for this proposal pursuant to WAC 197-11-340(2). The Responsible Official concluded that the proposal does not have a probable significant impact on the environment and an Environmental Impact Statement is not required pursuant to RCW 43.21.C.030(2)(c).

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2). The lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days. Comments must be submitted by May 17, 2012.

Pursuant to MMC 20.80.220(C)(5) there is no administrative appeal of a SEPA threshold determination associated with a city council legislative action.
