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#### CONDITIONS

- Tree replacement mitigation shall be in accordance with the approved Administrative Tree Activity
  Permit and the Tree Removal and Replacement Plan.
- 2. Trees shall be planted to allow each individual tree to mature. Individual trees shall be placed no closer than 10 feet from another tree.
- 3. Contact the City's tree consultant to schedule the following on-site meetings. 1. Post-planting inspection to ensure compliance with the conditions of this permit and that the planted trees have a reasonable chance of surviving.
- 4. Supplemental trees must meet the minimum standards established in MMC 16.52.100.
- 5. A revised Tree Planting Plan shall be submitted to the City for review if the location and species of supplemental plantings changes from what is shown on the approved plans.
