#### F. PRESENTATIONS

Ted Hunter, Medina Hearing Examiner. Training on Quasi-Judicial matters Power Point Presentation:

Medina Hearing Examiner's Ted Hunter and Andrew Reeves gave a presentation on conducting quasi-judicial hearings. Hunter and Reeves discussed topics such as open record hearings, due process, preponderance of evidence and justifying conditions of approval.

## G. PUBLIC HEARINGS

#### 1. QUASI JUDICIAL:

1. Level 2 Tailored Construction Mitigation Plan, File No. CMP-17-027 2021 Evergreen Point Road

**Applicant: Mark Nelson, Nelson Architecture (agent)** 

<u>Summary</u>: Redevelopment of a residential lot by demolishing the existing residence and constructing a new single-family dwelling with attached garage and decks and patios. Work includes grading up to 5,000 cubic yards of earth and removal of 22 significant trees.

Chair Schubring administered the Appearance of Fairness:

- Commissioner Nelson is the agent for the applicant and recused himself. He left the room.
- Chair Schubring disclosed he drove by the property.
- Commissioner Reeves disclosed he knows the contractor, Jason Williams.

There were no challenges to the remaining Commissioners deciding the matter.

Cristina Haworth, City Planning Consultant. She presented a summary of the staff report, adding an additional written comment as exhibit 10 and correcting miss labeled exhibit 5. Haworth recommended approving the Construction Mitigation Plan subject to the conditions proposed in the staff report.

Jason Williams, contractor for project, responded to questions from the Commissioners.

Chair Schubring opened the hearing to public testimony.

Yuri Manchik commented on structural coverage.

Commissioner asked questions and discussed the proposed Site Plan.

ACTION: Motion Reeves second Carlson to approve Construction Mitigation Plan CMP-17-027 with the conditions in the staff report and adding condition 2p to camouflage the portable toilets. Approved 5-0.

1. Discussion: Planning Commission/ City Council Communications:

2. Continued Discussion on Area-wide Map Amendment w/ school text amendments:

Grumbach reviewed the updated draft amendments with the Commissioners.

Bill Palmer, from St Thomas School, gave a brief presentation on a revised proposed site plan and responded to questions from the Commissioners. Palmer confirmed that the requested noise analysis will be submitted to the City before the next scheduled Planning Commission meeting.

ACTION: By consensus of the Commissioners, Grumbach will bring an updated draft amendment to the next meeting in preparation for the open house.
