1 E-BIKE CLASSIFICATIONS



CLASS 1 PEDAL ASSIST

- Motor works only when pedaling
- Max speed: 20 mph

TREATED AS A BICYCLE



CLASS 2 THROTTLE ASSIST

- Can move without pedaling
- Max speed: 20 mph

TREATED AS A BICYCLE



CLASS 3 HIGH-SPEED PEDAL ASSIST

- Pedal assist only (no throttle)
- Max speed: 28 mph

RESTRICTIONS APPLY

2 WHERE YOU CAN RIDE



CLASS 1 PEDAL ASSIST

- ✓ Streets & roadways
- ✓ Bike lanes
- ✓ Areas where bicycles are allowed



CLASS 2 THROTTLE ASSIST

- ✓ Streets & roadways
- ✓ Bike lanes
- ✓ Areas where bicycles are allowed



CLASS 3 HIGH-SPEED PEDAL ASSIST

- ✓ Streets, roadways & bike lanes
- ✗ NO sidewalks
- ✗ NO shared-use paths unless posted

3 LAWS & REGULATIONS

A vehicle is NOT considered an e-bike if it:

- Exceeds 750 watts
- Goes faster than 28 mph with motor
- Has no operable pedals
- Has been modified beyond legal limits

These are considered motor vehicles or motorcycles.



If classified as a motor vehicle:

Must be registered



Must carry insurance



Requires a driver's license



Subject to all motor vehicle laws



Follow all traffic laws and signals



Yield to pedestrians at all times



Ride at a safe and controlled speed



Use lights and visibility gear at night



Stay alert and aware of your surroundings
