GENERAL FUNCTION

Under immediate to general supervision, operates a variety of equipment in the maintenance, construction and repair of parks and open spaces, streets, storm drains, buildings, and other city facilities.

REPRESENTATIVE ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This list is intended only to illustrate the various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific Statements does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or logical assignment to the position.

- Maintains park and open space areas; mow, trim, prune trees and shrubs; cleans and maintains courts; maintains, installs, and repairs irrigation systems.
- Maintains parks; includes lawns, trees, shrubs, flowers, tables, benches, pathways, courts and playground.
- Performs minor maintenance of city facilities including City Hall, Public Works Shop, public restrooms, and shelters.
- Minor maintenance of landscape equipment: mowers, trimmers, blowers, chainsaws, etc.
- Operates mowers, trucks, utility vehicles, and other equipment as needed.
- Collects and disposes of garbage and recycle from city owned property.
- Inspects and/or repairs parks, streets and drainage systems to ensure that all systems are functioning properly.
- Maintains a variety of records relating to inspections and maintenance activity, etc.
- Fabricates, installs and maintains street signs and markings.
- During specific weather events, Maintenance Workers will perform snow removal operations which includes plowing, sanding and spreading de-icer on city streets and sidewalks.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Any combination of education or experience equivalent to graduation from high school and two (2) years of landscape maintenance or related public works maintenance and/or construction experience.

Special Requirements: A valid Washington State driver's license. Flagger and CPR certificates must be obtained within 6 month probationary period, training to be provided by City.
